

Parking Lot Contract

FUSD, FHS, AND PBHS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR VEHICLES AND THEIR CONTENTS WHILE PARKED ON SCHOOL GROUNDS. The Florence Unified School District provides bus transportation for students who live within its boundaries. In order to maintain a safe campus environment, minimize vandalism, and regulate use of student vehicles during school hours, the following regulations have been established:

- All student-driven vehicles, including motorcycles, must be registered in the front office and parked in the designated student parking area, in the assigned numbered parking space. Students may not park in any other lots on campus during the school day.
- Before students are issued a specific parking space, they must register the vehicle in the front office. Students must submit the required documentation at time of registration, and pay a fee of \$40.00 for the entire year. No per- semester or pro-rated parking is allowed.
- Students are issued a parking permit. The permit must be placed in the front windshield so that it is visible for school officials to see. The permit is NOT transferable to other vehicles without consent from the front office.
- Students who drive trucks are not permitted to have passengers in the back (bed) of the truck while on school grounds. Vehicles also may not contain hazardous materials,(i.e. gas cans, chemicals) while on campus.
- Causes for loss of parking privileges may include, but are not limited to: no vehicle tag, reckless driving, failure to drive courteously, failure to provide seatbelts for passengers, sharing parking spaces with unauthorized vehicles, failure to respond to school rules and authorities, intentionally damaging other vehicles, leaving campus without approval or parking in unauthorized areas.
- Vehicles are not to be used as lockers. Therefore, once school has begun, students may not return to their vehicles until the school day is over. Students are not permitted to sit in their cars and loiter in the parking lot.

Occurrence	Range of Discipline
1 st Offense	Conference and written warning (referral); community service or up to short term suspension
2 nd Offense	Up to short term suspension; loss of parking privileges for a quarter year
3 rd offense	Loss of parking permit

I understand that it is my responsibility to follow all school and district rules and guidelines. I understand that ignorance of any part of the parking lot rules will not be accepted as an excuse for not adhering to the parking contract. I agree to cooperate with and allow school officials to search my vehicle at any time. Failure to submit to a search will result in disciplinary consequences.
