Urban Wildlife/Urban Habitat (Urban) is 1 of 6 subcategories of the Arizona Game and Fish Heritage Grant (HG) program. Urban refers to Heritage Fund monies used for conserving, enhancing and establishing wildlife and wildlife habitat within, or in close proximity to, urban areas. Per Arizona Revised Statute “Urban Wildlife” is designated as wildlife that occurs within the limits of an incorporated area or in close proximity to an urban area that receives significant impact from human use. (A.R.S. 17-296(6)). Funds will be available under the Urban Wildlife/Urban Wildlife Habitat grant funding source for projects that conserve, enhance and establish wildlife habitats and populations in harmony with urban environments, and that increase public awareness of and support for urban wildlife resources.
